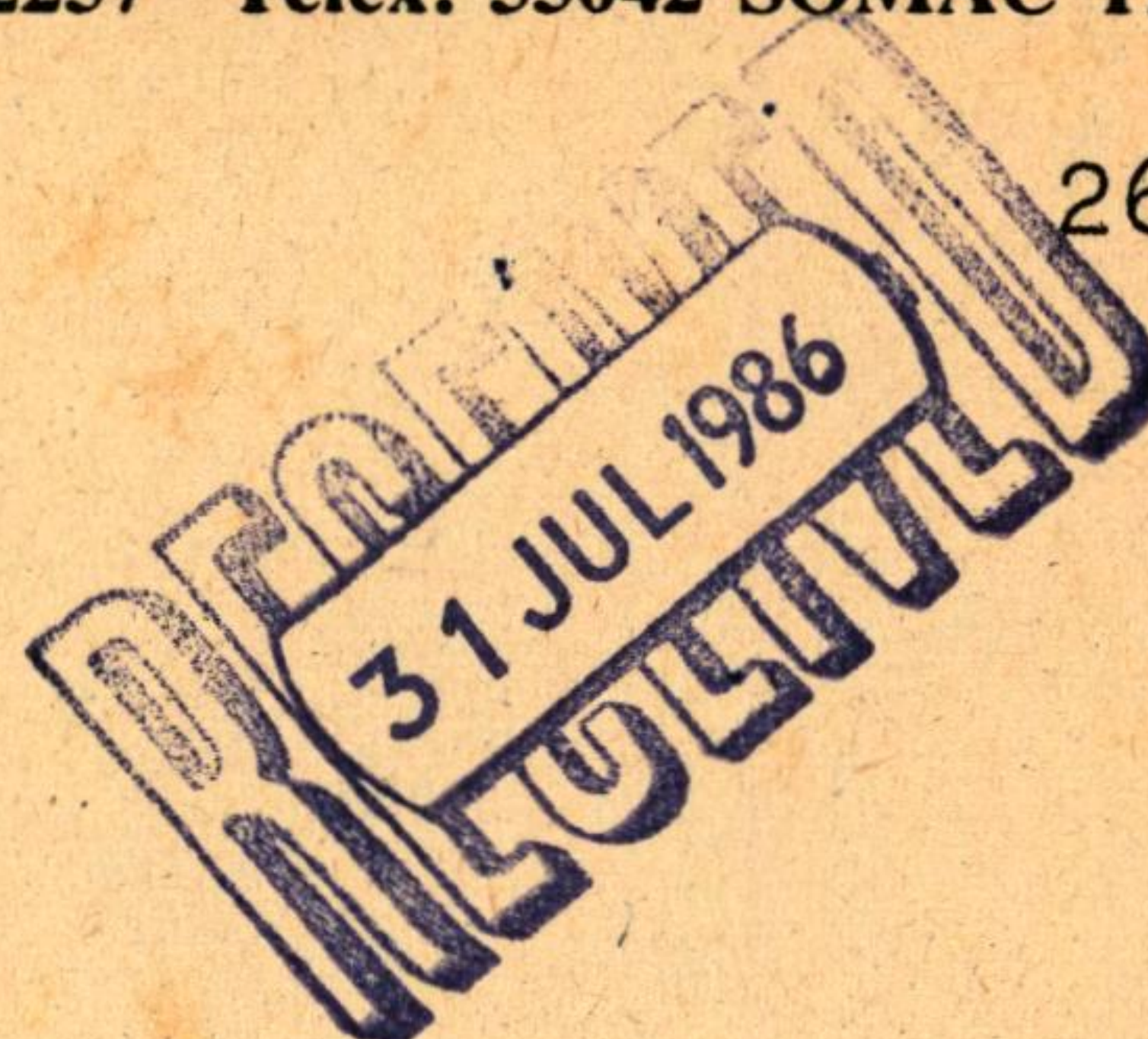

Dear Comrade Khaya,

Re: The Obligation of the African National Congress
Regarding the Students on Study; in Tanzania

Thank you for your letter dated 15/7/86. This is the matter we have raised before with the Secretary for Education and the Treasurer General and, among other things, we were advised to present an annual budget listing our financial needs for ANC scholars and for the administration and general costs of the NSC Office. We submitted a tentative request some 2 years ago but will now prepare a new one as soon as possible.

Re garding guidelines on financial and material support for scholars, may I propose that a meeting is conveyed between yourself, Comrade Maindy Msimang and the three members of the NSC Secretariat as soon as possible. Comrade Netsianda will convene this meeting.

Meanwhile, we will check on scholarship offers to ascertain what exactly the funding covers and what it does not. Comrade Msimang likewise will be able to inform us precisely what UNESCO and UNDP funding covers for those engaged in studies in Tanzania, and for those going beyond Tanzania.

As for Elizabeth Moleko's refusal to repay the loan, we shall make one more appael to her and if she fails to respond appropriately, the matter will be referred to the Chief Administrator for placement before the Disciplinary Committee.
