As far as I know there is none at all that can warrant such remarks.

A general requisition for transported was submitted to the R.C.H.Q. from this region, I can not remember now what and how many cars were requested for.

What I can tell you now is that we really need transport.

In the logistics for instance we have only two trucks and a toyota van. The toyota is beginning to give way because of this amount of work it is doing.

I hope you will come here according to your promise recently.
