Re: (a) WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS' STIPENDS AND (b) INCREASE OF STIPENDS FOR WUS
SPONSEES

I was sorry to miss our appointment this afternoon. I got delayed at another meeting.

Earlier on in the day we held a meeting of the WUS National Committee at which the two issues you raised in your letter of 12 June 1989 were discussed, and we agreed as follows:

1. that no withdrawals of students' stipends will be effected unless the Committee has made a decision to do so.
2. that the National Committee will apply to World University Service International in Geneva to have stipends increased at a rate to be determined by the Committee with effect from 1 January, 1990.
3. it is now too late to ask for an increase in the stipends for 1989 as the budget has already been determined and all the monies have been sent from Geneva.
