He informs me that the relevant Ministry in Rome has not as yet informed him in writing about bursary funds for 1994 for those students who were sponsored by Italy in 1993. However, he expects to receive written confirmation from Rome in about two weeks and he will there afterrwrite to all relevant institutions. Mr. Marole has reason to believe that the Programme will continue this year and felt concerned about the inconvenience caused to students and institutions as a result of the delay in confirming continued sponsorship in 1994.
