### Housing Committee Meeting

Present; Enos, Mongamelo, Nelson, Wilma and Kendrige.

Absent; Committee members from Copenhagen and Kliptown were not represented.

Cde. Enos gave an apology for the committee meeting minutes (11-10-84) which were not handed over to him by Cde. George due to his departure which was done so rapidly.

Cde. Wilma in the residential committee said they had discussed the question of Cde's who are not working, not because of their own fault but because of some problems, she said they should not be removed from occupying houses until their problems are solved.

Cde. Enos said most people are working presently and their problems were taken into consideration in advance.

Agenda; 1) Area surveillance 2) Tabora area committee.

Cde. Enos said that for the past weeks 5 Cde's. lost clothing in the Double-ups and 8 suitcases went missing in Tabora 8. The matter was taken to Cde. Chezi the government representative. Cde. Chezi surveyed the cases and said it's an inside job. The matter was taken to the Director and he came with a suggestion of surveying the area. The matter was left with the residential committee to discuss and introduce some way of guarding the area.

Cde. Wilma said that the matter should be discussed in the R.P.C and Youth units meetings.

Cde. Enos said the stealing is not only done by our Cde's. but the Mugambus were involved and it should be looked into properly. He emphasised that Cde's should keep their windows properly close to avoid any way of thieving. He went on to say we should watch the Tanzanian workers we are having around the complex. Proper keys are to be arranged for the D. houses since the keys presently used are not that safe. Cde's. were asked to save their places until proper guarding system has been introduced. He went on to say that the old houses had a problem to burglar proofed but the new ones will be burglar proofed.

Cde; Mongamelo asked on behalf of the Director that people should stop taking the girls of the chalotts out after midnight since it disturbs the guards. The area committee of Tabora who comprises of Cde. Moss as commissar, Cde. Chris as chairperson, Cde. Naledi as secretary and Cde. Zimpande and Christine. All of them had resigned since all powers were taken by Cde. Enos the housing officer.

Cde. Wilma asked if a meeting was held with the Tabora residential committee to find out their problems, she said the meeting should be held with both parties and problems discussed ( the general meeting).



Under general;

Cde. Enos said the building (3/4/9) is not complete because of a shortage of cement. But there are teachers who had no accomodation and the first preference should be given to them. The following Cde's. will be occupying the house (3/4/9) unite 4. Wilma and Sethunya the master bedroom Cde Aerbert, Mali, Joni and Stive will occupy the singles. The metter was left with the housing officer and people who are to say there.

Cde. Wilma wantad to know if students were allowed to cook in the residence and what time should they be there.

The matter was discussed befor by the housing officer and said the school area should come with a guide line.

Cde. Wilma said the residencial should discarage the students from drinking and send them to school during school hours. She went on to say the housing committee should write a letter to the principal for the guide line. She asked whom are the keys to be given to when leaving the complex for a short period of time and who will take care of the content in the room.

Cde. Enos replied that the key should be given to the chairperson of the area if the Cde. is going for a short period of time. He went on to say the first person to be contacted is the person if you are going to put the person in your room. The area committee is responsible for taking care of the room if the are any swaps the envitation should go to the chairperson first for for any swaps to take place and the people should be consulted.
