POSITION OF ANC HEALTH DESK ON ISSUES UNDER NEGOTIATION

- 1. The role of National Department of Health is to :-
- Determine National Health Policy
- Set minimum standards
- Set minimum targets e.g. for immunisation, for nutrition status.
- Allocate budgets
- 2. Regional and district authorities should be given budgets and have discretion to allocate resources according to local conditions and local need. However, they must fulfil national criteria as described in (1). There must be regional equity in resource allocating by national.

- 4. National health should be responsible for ensuing that appropriate legislation impacting on health should be in place.
- Maternity Rights

- 5. Concern about permanent status for civil servants being offered at present. Explain that this will have enormous implications for implementation of health policy suggest the following:-
- That civil servants both old and new be given a three year contract after elections in April, after which future confirmation of their job will depend on their performance over that period.
