This report is compiled in accordance to conditions set in the memorandum of agreement between the YET and Batlagae Trust. As required in the agreement, this report, will consist of two sections. One section will be a narrative report on the expenditure of the grant and the second section will be an academic progress report on each student. Also attached to the same report is a proposal for additional funding. The Youth Education Trust has been operating under extreme conditions as regards funding for the financial period June 1993 to July 1994. To date no funds have been received to cater fok academic support costs other than the Batlagae grant. As such this grant was overstretched in the sense that it was the only one available. In consultation with Batlagae it was agreed that we could prioritise and transfer from lesser pressing allocations to priority items as the situation dictated-

- 1. Since examinations are going to be held in June, 1994 it was 'felt that part of the money allocated for this category of expenditure could be used to cover for other pressing needs more especially feeding costs.
- 2. Teaching aids and learning material for two subjects (Fundamentals of Production and Environmental and Social Studies) was not yet available from ZIMFEP which meant that we could transfer that money into the feeding costs allocation.

- -Material for learning which is required will be for students individual study projects as required by the curriculum.
- -Lack of funds from donors made us to rely on Batalagae's grant as such this has to be augumented to adequately prepare for the exams in June, 1994.
