
Dear Friend,

Thank you for your letter of the 15th October
1971 wherein you inquired about Comrade Miya's health.

Comrade Miya is now prepared to be treated in the
USSR. What has delayed this matter to be finalised with the
Embassy is the fact that the Doctor from whom we should get
the medical certificate was not co-operative, but eventually
he has agreed to issue Comrade Miya with a medical certificate.

certificate to Dar or send it to the Embassy here. A letter
to the Solidarity Committee was sent to them but no reply
has been received yet, perhaps your office should advice how
to treat this matter.
