Hargreaves first local one man exhibition was held af the Adler Fielding Gallery in Johannesburg in 1967. Other local exhibitions followed in 1972. He exhibited some of his work

in Salisbury, Now Harare in Zimbabwe, al the African School of Arl His first overseas o ne man

exhibition took place in London in 1973 and from there exhibitions were held in Paris, Munich,

Frankfurt, Denhasg and Bonn.

Niukwana \hat{a} 200\231s work is popular in the United States of America where he has exhibit ed extensively since his first exhibition there in Boston in 1974.

Subsequently he was contracted by an American gallery to tour the USA with his work.

Hargreaves, who lives in Dlamini, first gained recognition for his art when he designed a cover for the album $\hat{a}200\234D$ ollar Brand Underground in Africa $\hat{a}200\235$.

He went on to design for Letta Mbuluâ $\200\231s$ record company, and also painted the designs for the

costumes of the cast of the mutiracial show $\hat{a}200\234Black$ and White is Beautifulâ\200 \235 which toured overseas with Welcome Msomi.

Hargreaves, who is also an accomplished sculptor and musician — te plays double bass, s ${\tt ax}$

and piano - has also lectured on South African art both here and in the USA

Born at Crown Mines in Johannesburg on 17 June, 1938, he werd to school locally – and then disappointed his father, a mine clerk, by rejecting medicine as a career and instead

studying fine art and music.

He worked a3 a messenger and a clerk to pay for his tuition in fine art, including a sp ell at

the Artists \hat{a} 200 \hat{c} 31 Colony in Toledo, Spain where he studied under the master Costa Li des who died at the age of 100 in 1979.

His more recent exhibitions abroad were in Denmark, Zurick and San Diego in February 1986. There is acurrent exhibition of his work and 25 other South African Black artists at the

Ogelthor pe University Art Gallery in Atlanta Georgia.

Hargreaves uses the technique of blowing diluted oils onto paper, wiping the excess wit ${\bf h}$

cloth and cotton swabs then inking over the colour background when it is dry.
