AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP, HE STUD IED AT \FORT HARE COLLEGE, GRADUATING WITH A B.SC. DEGREE IN 194 1. HE THEN REMAINED IN FORT HARE TO QUALIFY FOR A DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION I BUT PWAS EXCELLED DURING A â-STUDENTS' STRIKE IN 1942. -ST. ON HIS RETURN TO JOHANNESBURG, TAM30 QUICKLY 3ECAME D RAWN INTO A GROUP OF YOUNG MILITANTS PRESSING FOR MORE MILITANT DIR ECTION IN THE
