Work report; participation on the lobbying, picketing etc. of the Ontario Government Trade mission to South Africa. Reports indicate that the campaign came close to success and if efforts sustained will probably be the last. Actions, received wide support. Notably, the Black Coalition, TCLPAC, Churches, N.D.P., C.P., Y.CL, Ontario Federation of Labour, United Steel workers of America, message of solidarity from the Canadian Labour Congress.

Ontario Federation of Labour. Reception to ANC information table at annual convention positively received, succesful initiation of petition campaign to free S.A. political prisoners. Observation of procedure very positive experience.
