AFRICAN LIBERATION WEEK PROPOSAL

INTRODUCTION

The anniversary of the founding of the Organization of African Unity (OAU) presents an opportunity to celebrate the accomplishments of the organization. It also presents an opportunity to educate those around us about the people of the continent, their struggles for liberation and the challenges which still face the continent.

.In many African countries and in the diaspora, African Liberation Day is celebrated in conjunction with OAU Day. Usually included in this celebration are a host of activities such as lectures, symposiums, concerts, festivals and parties. In Japan however, such events are not conducted. While an OAU reception is held annually, events which inform the public are conspicuously absent.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this proposal is to bring about public awareness of the OAU and African Liberation Day through the coordination of various events by the African Embassies and other governmental and non-governmental organizations in Japan.

hUDGET

The budget will include the cost of the lecture hall which will be paid for by JAFA. This lecture will serve as the organization's monthly meeting. A small entry fee will be charged to cover any additional expenses.
