(a) Claim on the carriers and/or the Port Authorities for any missing packages.
(b) When delivery is made by container, ensure that the container and its seals are examined immediately by their responsible official. If the container is delivered damaged or with seals broken or missing or with seals other than as stated in the shipping documents, clause the delivery receipt accordingly and retain all defective or irregular seals for subsequent identification.
(c) Arrange immediately for a joint survey in the docks with carriers' representative if any loss or damage be apparent on delivery from the ship, and claim on the carriers for any actual loss or damage found at such survey.
(d) In no circumstances give clean receipts where goods are in doubtful condition, except under written protest.
