THE ESTABLISHMENT 0!" A NATIONAL INSTITUTE FOR  
TECHNOLOGY LEADERSHIP (NITL)

We are currently working on the establishment of a National Institute for  
Technology Leadership which will play a vital role in building South Africa:  
international competitiveness in the future. The NITL will provide a multi-e  
training and education with talented people in companies and the community in  
technology leadership and technologist literacy in collaboration with  
universities, etc. The NITL also provide information and services to  
companies and industries in respect of their international competitiveness.  
The NITL is a prime company with directors who are being appointed on the  
basis of their experience in technology, management and industry leadership  
development.

Several important organisations, companies and individuals have endorsed the  
principle of establishing NITL as a commercial multi-company / multi-industry  
/ academic / government institution / labour collaboration or joint venture to  
improve national competitiveness.

We think that the NITL will play a crucial role in accelerating changes in  
paradigms and ability in the four areas: population it will focus on. It will  
populations and the future industry leaders, future academic leaders, future local  
government leaders and the young entrepreneurs. The strategic focus will be on  
creating and building an understanding of international competitiveness and the  
skills which are required for it.

The NHL will operate as a national and international network organisation with a very small staff. Three of them: education and training institutions. One in the UK and one in France have expressed their commitment to participate in the NITL. South African institutions are also interested. If you decide to allow me these minutes of your time I will concentrate my briefing on the following: '

the need for private companies to participate in the future role of

the service's and products of the NHL;

the NHL, as seen by you;  
the cost and benefits or membership of the NHL.

I know you are very busy and that you have limited time to spend on  
approaches like this. but I wish to ensure you that this is a matter of strategic  
national importance. which has already raised the enthusiasm and commitment  
of many people. Many people have indicated that they wish to be  
associated with this initiative.

I am looking forward to discussing this matter with you as soon as possible.
