THE LATE GOPAUL MANICUM â\200\224 A TRIBUTE

Commencing his cricket career with the Young Natalians Cricket Club, the late
Gopaul Manicum began playing representative cricket at high school in 1956, cap-
taining the Natal High Schools team in 1960-61 against the visiting â\200\230Baslingsâ
\200\231.

At Currieâ\200\231s Fountain, Durban, in 1967 he achieved the distinction of capturing
the
wicket of the England test star, Basil Dâ\200\231Oliviera, twice in the match. On a tou
r of
Rhodesia and Zambia with the Northern Natal team, he headed the bowling averages.

The greatest moment for Gopaul â\200\224 and for Natal cricket â\200\224 was leading th
e Natal
team to victory under his brilliant captaincy in the SACBOC Dadabhai Cup
competition in the late sixties.

He was rated by many, at the time, as the finest off-spin bowler in the country who
would have made any South African team chosen on merit.

In 1973 Gopaul left Young Natalians to found the historic Aurora Cricket Club
under the NCA but re-joined the folds of the NCB bringing Aurora, which he cap-
tained, with him. Gopaul was still an active member of his team when his illustrious
career ended with his tragic demise in July 1979.
