- mosquito nets
- registration

Apart from this material support we need advice and immaterial support by specialists in parasitology.

Justification We enclose a full description of the antimalaria campaign

Items needed -we need tools to deal with pools and swamps.

- material to produce mosquito nets
- spray units and insecticides
- constant feedback on our campaign results.

Follow up: We hope to be able to evaluate the campaign by registering all malaria cases.
