



EBLANTRÉ (eMalawi), - Owabangumangeli wokuqala eMalawi, uDr Kamuzu Hastings Banda, uzohekana namacala okubulala abantu abane ngombango wezepolitiki abafu ngo-1983. UDr Banda, oboshelwe emzini wakhe, ungene kulonoxhaka nomngani wakhe omkhulu, uMnu John Tembo, bobabili okuthiwa bayanukela ngalamacala.

Ongqongqoshe baka-hulumeni wakhona batshela abezindaba ukuthi uDr Banda noMnu Tembo kulindeleke bavele enkantolo emuva kwa-maviki amane noma asithupha. Kuthiwa kunele kwezwakala lezindaba abeqembu i-Lithuleni obusayo i-United Demo-cratic Front bavuka em-bhejizana bagasela emahhovisi eqembu likaBanda babulala izinto bazi-tapela konke obekupha-kathi bebulala namafasi-tela.

UDr Banda ubuse elaseMalawi iminyaka engaphezu kuka-20 kusukela lezizwe lathatha inkululeko yalo kwelase-Britani ngo-1964. UDr Banda oneminyaka yobu-dala eku-90 wanele wa-thatha izintambo zombu-so, wawavala imilomo wonke amaqembu kwa-khona elakhe, iMalawi Congress Party. Yena wazigidi labazama ngoku-nkulu sokubangomanga-meli imipho yakhe yonke. Ethu uma kuqubeka abaphikisayo uyobajezisa ngobathuthela ezizibeni badiwe yizingwenya.



Star Schools

IN 1988, matric students at Robin Hood College in Johannesburg wrote examinations in their own Robin Hood examination centre for the first time.

In 1988 and 1990 the college achieved matric pass rates above the national average and the first Robin Hood College matric students passed through the portals of Wits University.

In 1989, a sister school, Santa Francesca Primary and High School was established in Durban. It is an English medium school run by a qualified headmaster, vice-principal and highly qualified teachers.

The classes are open to boys and girls from class one to matric, and the average class holds between 25 and 30 pupils with smaller study and remedial groups. Students also receive extra coaching on Saturday mornings to upgrade their performances if necessary.

Santa Francesca Primary and High School and Robin Hood College provide a continuous and intensive co-educational course of education from junior primary to matric and pride themselves in the excellent rapport that exists between directors, staff and students.


