A South African citizen by registration or naturalization may in certain circuml I stances lose his South African citizenship by continued residence abroad. 1 South African citizens are strongly advised to register with the nearest South African representative abroad. Failure to register or thereafter to report any change of address, may cause difficulty and delay in rendering assistance and protection.

Dual nationality.

Persons bom abroad of South African parents, or born in South Africa of alien parents, women who are or have been married and naturalized persons may possibly also possess, in addition to South African Citizenship, the nationality of a foreign country. When in that foreign country, such persons cannot avail themselves of the protection of South African representatives against the authorities of the foreign country and are not exempt by reason of possessing South African citizenship, from any obligation (such as military service) to which they may be liable under the foreign law.

Surrender of South African passports.

The bearer of a South African passport may not hold a passport of another country at the same time. The validity of this passport expires and it must be surrendered to the Department of Home Affairs or to the nearest South African representative whenever the holder\_

- (i) loses. relinquishes or is deprived of his South African citizenship; (ii) possesses, in addition to South African citizenship, the citizenship or nationality of another country and applies for a passpon or that country; or
- (iii) obtains a passport of another country under any circumstances whatsoever.

## CAUTION

This passport is a valuable document, and should not be allowed to pass into the possession of any unauthorized person. Travellers are advised to retain their passports on their persons at all times especially in foreign countries. If the passport is lost or destroyed, the fact should be reported immediately to the Department of Home Affairs, Pretoria, or to the nearest South African representative and to the local police authorities. A new passport can only be issued in such cases after exhaustive inquiries.
