0.0 Total figure of the ANC membership in Zambia.

0.1 The total figure of the ANC community is fluctuating.Last the community was amounting to ±700.The ANC has received additional people however others have gone to school abroad,many others are committed to military courses abroad and also those who joined the UNHCR.The ANC delegation shall prepare a list of all the above categories and submit to the ALC.

0.2 The ANC delegation explained to Lt Col Makumbi that the

Commission for External Organisation is responsible for the reduction of the movement's personnel from the region.Also that numbers of comrades are drawn from other places abroad for deployment in Zambia.For one reason or the other they are damped at some stage therefor increasing the numbers of people categorised as undeployed.The ANC delegation submitted a copy of minutes of the Task Force dated 23/03/89 as proof that the ANC is interested in reducing it's membership from the region.

0.3 The Zambian government has got records to the effect that there are 300 members of the ANC and members of the National executive committee in Zambia.However this does not suggest that the Government expect only the said figure in the region.

1.0 Total number of weapons the Movement have in Zambia.

1.1 Cde Lt Col Makumbi indicated the importance of registering all weapons that the Movement has. He pointed out that this assist the Zambian authorities in cases where shootings take place because it becomes easy in their work during investigations. When weapons are confiscated, it becomes very easy for the ANC to get them back when registered. However the ANC delegation indicated that the process of registering weapons have started.

1.2 Another matter arising from the last discussion the ANC had with ALC was that all ANC major installations shall be guarded by the Zambian authorities. The government is still considering the matter.

2.0 Total number of people authorised to arm.

Cde Reddy from the ANC delegation shall compile a list of ANC personnel authorised to be armed and submit it together with the list of weapons that the Movement has in the region.

3.0 AOB.

3.1 The Movement shall submit a list of important objects and installations so that the local night patrols should communicate with ANC comrades occupying those installations to avoid unnecessary risks of confrontation.
