MEMORANDUM

TO : All invitees to ANC Donors Conference

FROM : D.C. Secretariat

RE : Information on Donors Conference

1. The ANC Donors Conference will take place at the Arusha International Conference Centre in Arusha, Tanzania from 6 - 8 February, 1990.

2. The Conference will be attended by over 200 representatives of Government, International and Non-Governmental development and aid organisations. The South African delegation will comprise representatives of ANC departments, ANC missions abroad, regional representatives of the ANC and other mass based organisations in South Africa, progressive internal South African NGO's and representatives of project holders from South Africa on a sectoral basis.

3. The ANC/Mass Democratic Movement will present policies, strategies and priorities for internal and external development programmes and projects.

4. Invitees will be required to participate in Conference plenary and commission sessions and to identify areas and projects for which they will provide assistance.

Conference participants will have the opportunity to visit two major ANC projects in Morogoro, Tanzania: Solomon Mahlangu Freedom College (SOMAFCO) at the Mazimbu Complex and the ANC Dakawa Development Centre. Prior to the Conference on 4 February 1991 and again following Conference on 11 February, transport will be arranged leaving Dar-es-Salaam early in the morning and returning in the evening. Those wishing to visit these settlements are requested to make their flight reservations and Dar-es-Salaam hotel bookings accordingly.

Any participant wishing to visit outside of the above-mentioned dates is requested to inform us of this and make early requests if transport is needed.

Each organisation is expected to meet the costs of participation by its representatives for travel, accommodation, trips and meals.

Each organisation is expected to make own travel and accommodation arrangements. However, to facilitate this process the Preparatory Secretariat will make block reservations for certain flight routes into Dar-es-Salaam, book charter planes for flights from Dar-es-Salaam to Arusha and back and arrange airport transfers.
