Some time in 1985 I spoke to Prof Makeni, about possibilities of doing a refresher course in general medicine in the Muhimbili Medical Centre. He assured me that such possibilities exist and that the course should last one academic year, with the intake in July.

I would like to do such a course in 1988.

I did internship in Muhimbili Hospital (then) for one year beginning in November 1972, after which I worked in the various wards (Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynaecology), as Registrar and finally as Medical Officer in charge in Casualty in the last six months of 1976.

I left employment under Afya at the end of December 1976 to join my organisation the African National Congress of South Africa, full time.

Could you then please send me information (prospectus, or tuition charges, boarding and lodging, library charges (if any) and so on) to enable me to prepare adequately for admission.

I have in the meantime applied for a fellowship from the World Health Organisation.

Should your reply for my admission be possitive please also send such and any relevant information to the Regional Director, Who in Brazzaville through their local office in Dar-es-Salaam.
