(c) Those attending the Annual National General Congress are not bound by any mandate on any question. Debate must be free and every delegate must be free to discuss and vote in accordance with their own individual views and conclusions. It shall however be the task and duty of the delegates to convey to the ANG the majority views of their regions, zones and local youth organisation on any question discussed.

2.7.2 The Federation's National Congress shall meet once a year as the supreme decision making body of the Federation.
