Dear Dr. Tambo:

I am trying to do for the world what I have

done for my child; because if I don't my child will not have a world to live in, in the future.

When any child dies because of a mans greed or racial ego that

is wrong; and I will try to find a way to stop him.

The tide of jumanity is turning against P.W. Botha's regime and in favor of your side doctor. As you so aptly put it on Mr. Koppel's "Nightline".

"People are going to be people; no matter what, they shall evolve into what their mass consceinceness dictates in the end".

Why should the Black Africans suffer any longer? They should not. Why should everything be destroyed only to be replaced by more suffering. If the A.N.C. were to disregard Mr. Neo Mnumzana's retoric that I heard on Mr. Koppel's Nightline program; change its position slighty and incorporate and assimulate South Africa's economic system, I believ e

you would be extremly successful in your indeavors without the loss of life and bloodshed.

Yourself, Nelson Manelela, and Arch-Bishop elect Desmond Tutu I see as the future Simon Bolivar's of Africa. Help your people prosper and let them evolve as thier conscience dictates.

Apparently there is a vast wealth, (financially) involved. As I see it; this is why the likes of Mr. P.W. Botha are so desperately trying to hold on. Use this knowledge to your advantage.

Yes, aparthied should die, help that happen, but, no, your people and their prosperity should not die, also let that not happen.

Remember in your difficult days ahead, that, I truly admire and respect you.
