THE NURSERY: THE PRIMARY SCHOOL;
THE SECONDARY SCHOOL AND THE
DAKAWA RECEPTION CENTRE.

THEY ARE NOT PHYSICALLY CLOSE TOGETHER AND WE HAVE FOUND THAT IT IS BAD TO MOVE AUDIO-VISUAL EQUIPMENT AROUND. IDEALLY, EACH CENTRE SHOULD HAVE ITS OWN PROJECTOR. AT THE MOMENT WE HAVE ONLY ONE (1).

ONCE THIS PROJECT IS ADOPTED, THE DONE SHOULD CONTACT THE PRINCIPAL DIRECT - WE CAN THEN WORK OUT THE NECESSARY DETAILS. THANK YOU.

OUR BASIC REQUIREMENTS ARE:

- 1) SLIDE PROJECTOR: We would prefer a Zeiss Ikon Perkeo Autofocus S 250 or the nearest available model, because we have one machine and it would help in stocking spares to get a similar one.
- 2) MAGAZINES: For 50 Slides. - Quantity - 10
- 3) SPARE LAMPS: For the Projector - Quantity - 5
- 4) REPAIR MANUAL: For the Projector - Quantity - 1
- 5) SPARE DRIVE BELTS: And any other commonly needed spares - 2 Sets.
- 6) SLIDE STORAGE CABINET: For 1,000 Slides - 1
(Suitable for Tropical climate)
- 7) SCREEN: Portable for Classroom use - 1
