NEC STATEMENT ON MAZIMBU/DAKAWA

- 1. An ANC Delegation led by Mr. Thomas Nkobi, Treasurer-General, visited Tanzania from March 3rd to 6th 1992 for talks with Government and Party officials.
- 2. The ANC Delegation delivered a letter from the President of the ANC, Mr. Nelson Mandela, to President Ali Hassan Mwinyi of Tanzania, conveying the National Executive Committee of the ANC to handover the Settlements of Mazimbu and Dakawa to Tanzania by the end of June 1992.
- 3. It was agreed to handover the Settlements to Chama Cha Mapinduzi (CCM) which will be responsible for agreeing with the Government the terms of their use. In this regard the paramount goal would be to serve the interests of the people of Tanzania
- 4. A Joint Tanzania/ANC Working Committee has been established to recommend the future use of Mazimbu and Dakawa and to work out the modalities of the transfer of the Settlements.
- 5. The Joint Working Committee will give ample opportunity to Nordic donors to offer their advice on the future use of the Settlements.
- 6. It was agreed to facilitate the completion of work and maintenance programmes still under donor assistance.
- 7. The two delegations paid special tribute to the generosity of Nordic countries towards the development of Mazimbu and Dakawa.
- 8. A handover ceremony will be held in June to effect the transfer of the Settlements from the ANC to Tanzania.
