Its tenacity and resourcefullness amongst other things emerged from the ability to recover from 1963 Rivonia arrests, whereby the whole underground leadership including Nelson Mandela was captured by the enemy.

Despite this tragic loss at the infancy of armed struggle, we have become a force for both foe and friends. Perhaps in the recent past, the heroic Soweto Uprising is one of the momentous periods in the life of our movement and people.

It ushered in a qualitative new phase in the struggle and acceptance by the oppressed majority that victory lies in revolutionary violance for a democratic future.

As we observe the 75th Anniversary of the ANC, our task lies v^v further taking the war to the enemy, guaranteeing the present decade as that of liberation. Our main blows are to be directed in the areas where the enemy power is concentrated, striking powerful blows at its military, economic and administrative structures and resources. Special responsibility lies on the shoulders of Umkhonto We Sizwe in# giving the enemy no quarter, while building its combat forces in^national and social composition.

In the wake of the current Pretoria imposed 'State of Emergency', strengthening our underground role and providing the lead on the way forward, is crucial. The ANC is the people and its victory lies in their action.

close commercial relations icn South Africa as well as capital investments. The racist Airforce boasts of squadrons manufactured in Prance and, or at home under licence. These economic ties equally find expression in the politico-diplomatic field/relations.

Experience and necessity dictated the course of armed struggle as the only alternative to achieve the set political objectives of the national liberation movement. The reactionary violance has to be replied with revolutionary violence of the popular masses. The current phase of the struggle is>thanks to that timely decision 25 years ago.

To you the future of mankind about to demonstrate your love for freedom and equality of humanity, Nelson Mandela is a symbol and embodiment of the determined will and conviction of the S.A people to crush apartheid colonial domination. Having chosen May 9th the Anniversary of the victory of humanity over forces of fascism, your commitment and contribution to our liberation is highly appreciable. Focus your attention also to the plight of your S.A counterparts languishing in racist dungeons and concentration camps for having darred to rise and fight for their peoples liberation..

The present political situation in South Africa is characterised by firstly a general highliting of the struggle for liberation,. This state of affairs has ushered in a new phase in our struggle - a phase where there exists now, in our country, dual power. Locally, the people are in control and run their own affair® whilst centrally the racists are still at the helmc Secondly, the question of peoples war has seized to be subject of theoretical debates. It has now begun to take root»

The past two years has seen the emergence of mass combat units created by our people, especially the youth to defend the people and the leadership from criminal harrassment by the racists and their agents and to take on the enemy and make sure that the revolutionary gains thus far made by our people ar§ not reversed«

A process to intergrate these mass combat units into the units of Umkhonto We Dizwe is well underway. In some cases, these intergrated units have already engaged the enemy in a number of daring actions. Thirdly, there has been in the recent past a growth of international support of the struggle for liberation more and more countries are beginning to take some form of action against the apartheid regime. In this regard, the Scandinavian Countries have played a very prominent role. Furthermore, more governments especially those from the West have come to recognise the fact that the ANC is central to the solution of the South African problem,, In this category falls even those countries and governments which are traditionally allies of apartheid such as the Reagan and Thatcher administrations. Fourtly, the heightening

of the struggle has put the racists in the worst crisis in their history. The ruling clique of South Africa is experiencing splits at every form. This, therefore, makes us believe that the racist can never extricate themselves from the present crisis. This is especially so since the racists have failed so far to come with a viable solution to the problems that confront theme On these developments, therefore, is based our optimism for the future.
