ANC - SA MISSION IN LUSAKA ZAMBIA

MEETING OF - MISSION ADMINISTRATION

DATE: 11 OCT, 1991

TIME: 16 Hours

VENUE: Mission Conference Hall

AGENDA: Special request for mission staff + students accomodation/houses, and house hold goods/furniture, Curtlery. Staff members without accomodation Bram Mogane, Dexter, Charles, Matthews and Fred.

PRESENT IN THE MEETING: Chief Rep Cde Ndlovu, Dexter, Bram, Charles, City and Fred.

ABSENT: Cde Aulolo and Mancheck.

The meeting was officially opened by the Chief Rep and pointed out that there is an urgent need for us to sort out accomodation problem in this region before Cdes Mlangeni and Malome Manci leave for Johannesburg H.Q

This was in line with the on going confusion concerning Cdes who just vacate ANC houses or putting in some Zambian friends, relatives and Cdes who are not supposed to remain in this region officially.

All this is taking place without the knowledge of the mission or without following the right procedure/channels. In light of this unpleasant event the mission has taken the responsibility upon its self to see to it that straight record of ANC houses and our Community in this region are properly kept, so as to curb unnecessary rentals expenditures and compensation of land lords for their damaged houses as a result of vandalization because this kind of practise is dwindling/draining the coffers of our movement. From time to time and it is our rightful duty as a mission to put and end to this with emediate effect.

Again the Chief Rep has emphasized the need to form/creat a body which will be handling matters related to housing problems in order to facilitate the smooth running of the already mentioned exercise.

This body i.e Housing Committee will work hand in glove with the mission Administration. Cde Bram was then requested by the Chief Rep to furnish the meeting with the list of ANC houses in Lusaka. The list was previously compiled by Socha and Bram, but we have encountered problems because Cde Socha did'nt have a complete record of the above mentioned items at hand.

All the same the list of identified houses is as follows:

AVONDALE: 1. O.R house - along great east road.  
2. Zola Skweviya's house - not very sure of the place.  
3. J.M's house  
4. Nkademeng's house } same yard/one yard.

OLIMPIA PARK: 1. SACTU house - on sale.

NORTH MEAD: 1. Uncle Dan's house.  
2. Chief Rep's house and to serve as guest house for - leadership



- WOODLANDS EXTENSION:
1. Chawe's House
  2. Marry's House
  3. Maleroie's House
  4. Tembo's House - former O.R.'s - not very sure of the place
  5. Former military house
- LUMUMBA ROAD:
1. Former Women section office presently occupied by Regional Nat
- KABWATA:
1. Nkula's House - former R.P.C office
- HELLEN KAUNDA
1. Steeward house - not very sure
- ENTIASDALE:
1. Former creche + R.C for female students
- LILANDA:
1. Lehlohonolo's house
  2. Mzwai's house
  3. Green house
  4. Makiwane's house - along Impala Road
  5. Lilanda stores main Res. Now earmarked for visitors to serve as a sort of quest house
  6. Mchawanga
- MAKENI:
1. Former DIP house: earmarked for male students - to be furnish ~~it~~ with bedings

We would like to draw your attention to the effect that all most/all of these houses are partially or fully occupied. The administration has been assigned a task of physically going around taking stock of the said houses and try to scout for some more ANC houses which dont appear on this list.

This could be accomplished only by collecting related information from Socha's records and making use of individuals.

Lastly the special request was made concerning Malome's house hold goods not to be transfered all of it to Johannesburg, so that the remaining part could be utilized by some of our Cdes in this region.

GENERAL: Chief Rep should have a Zambian driver very urgently.
