The meeting was officially opened by the Curer nep and point, our that there is an urgent need for us to sort out acco, odation problem in this region before Cdes Mlangeni and Malome Manci leave for Johannesburg H.Q

This was in line with the on going confusion concerning Cdes who just vacate ANC houses or putting in some Zambian friends, relatives and Cdes who are not supposed to remain in this region officially.

All this is taking place without the knowledge of the mission or without following the right proceedure/channels. In light of this unpleasant exent the mission has taken the responsibility upon its self to see to it that straight record of ANC houses and our Community in this region are propperly kept, so as to curb unecessary rentals expenditures and compendation of land lords for their damaged houses as a result of vandalization because this kind of practise is dwindling/draining the coffers of our movement from time to time and it is our rightful duty as a mission to put and end to this with emediate effect.

Again the Chief Kep has emphasized the need to form/creat a body which will be handling matters related to housing problems in order to facilitate the smooth remaine of the already mentioned exercise.

This body i.e Housing Committee will work hand in glove with the mission Administration. Cde Bram was then requested by the Chief Rep to furnish the meeting with the list of ANC houses in Lusaka. The list was previously compiled by Socha and Bram, but we have encourtered problems because Cde Socha did'nt have a complete record of the above mentioned items at hand.

We would like to draw your attention to the effect that all most/all of these houses are partially or fully occupied. The administration has been asigned a task of physically going around taking stock of the said houses and try to scout for some more ANC houses which don't appear on this list.

This could be accomplished only by collecting related information from Socha's records and making use of individuals.

Lastly the special request was made concerning Malome's house hold goods not to be transferred all of it to Johannesburg, so that the remaining part could be utilized by some of our Cdes in this region.

GENERAL: Chief Rep should have a Zambian driver very urgently.
