The photographs on show have been selected from the book JOHANNESBURG:  
IMAGES AND CONTINUITIES, a history of working class life through pictures  
1885 - 1935, by Peter Kallaway and Patrick Pearson.

Kallaway and Pearson, one an antropologist , the other an historian collaborated  
to present a pictorial history from 1885. The book engages many significant  
themes in the making of the modern Witwatersrand. The photographs range  
from shots of early removals to prints of British soldiers checking "passes"  
during the Anglo- Boer War.
