SUBJECT: URGENT APPEAL ON THE SOLUTION OF THE FOOD PROBLEM IN THE REGION

Cde President, we are facing a serious food crisis which needs the immediate attention of your office.

Currently, our student community have nothing to live on. It is in our knowlcdae chat nll Annor organisations have been ordered to cease their support pertaining food. accommodation, transport ailocatluu and medlual allowances by our Treasurer General OffiCe';

This has led to Students having to cope up with miserable and deplorable conditions healthwise together with the standard of living. What we can afford for maintenance is ' ' T; zero, in so far as ANC allowances are concerned. The donor organisations, conversely, are prepared to give us daily nedessities. It only needs the Treasurer General to consult the donor headquarters as pertaining the plight of ANC students in the region. We therefore appeal to you as the Fether Commander in-chief and President, of the ANC to urgently respond to our needs.

For emphasis purposes comrade, we will repeat to say that the Treasurer General ordered the donor organisations to cease all assistance on the basis that the ANC will provide its cadres with food, clothing, accommodation and medical allowances. Now the local donors say it will only take the Treasurer General to amend or revoke the previously agreed minutes. The situation is tragic to say the least Comrade President. We do not want to think that the organisation has abandoned our right to education as enshrined in the Freedom Charter.

Kindly consider that we are arming ourselves academically in order to replenish and re-enforce the human resources and manpower of the ANC for a future South Africa.
