A G R E E M E N T

between

3.1. The item 3.1. above, foundation materials, NF will transfer the African National Congress (hereinafter referred to as ANC) of 14th Feb. (items 3 and 3.3. covering imported materials), the Norsk Folkehjelp (hereinafter referred to as NF) printing documents. The sum of USD. 44.000,- for local materials (item 3.2. of the estimate) will be transferred to ANC on completion of all foundation work.

The two parties agree to cooperate in the construction of a health and training centre in the ANC Vocational Training and Self-Reliance Centre at Viena, Angola.

This agreement to implement the project confirms the intentions outlined in the agreement of 1982 between the ANC Health Department and NF, as well as the subsequent protocol of Feb. 9th 1984 in Stockholm.

Amount of labour, office expenses, design and planning in the amount of USD. 22.000,- will be transferred to the ANC

OBLIGATIONS OF NF

1. NF will provide financing as a grant to construct the following buildings including foundations:
 - 1 clinic, Reception
 - 1 classroom/library block
 - 1 classroom block
 - 2 dormitory blocks
 - 1 house (3 bedrooms)
 - 1 kitchen/dining hall
 - 1 ablution block

4. ANC undertakes to ensure the coordination and implementation

4.3. Every three months ANC will draw up a construction progress report as well as final report.

4.4. On completion of the construction ANC will prepare and present a settlement of account.

3. The transfer of funds and payments will be made as follows:

3.1. The item 2.1. above, foundation materials, NF will transfer to Finnsolidarity, in accordance with the cost estimate of 14th Feb. (items 3.1. and 3.3. covering imported materials), the sum of USD 34.000,- against receipt of shipping documents. The sum of USD. 10.000,- for local materials (item 3.2. of the estimate) will be transferred to Finnsolidarity on completion of all foundation work.

3.2. For imported materials, transport and erection (item 2.2.) NF will open an irrevocable, confirmed letter of credit in the amount of USD. 480.000,- to the contractor. This letter of credit will be managed by the ANC or its representative.

3.3. Payment of labour, office expenses, design and planning in the amount of USD. 22.000,- will be transferred to the ANC one month after signature of the constructors contract. The remaining USD. 12.000,- for travel expenses will be settled at the end of the construction contract.

3.4. Any expenses not included in the above mentioned items will be paid from a contingency sum of USD. 61.000,- after approval by NF or its representative on request from the ANC.

OBLIGATIONS OF ANC

4. ANC undertakes to ensure the coordination and implementation of the construction.

4.1. ANC will provide the needed manpower and supervision for the construction.

4.2. ANC will implement all infrastructure, works including roads, water, sewage, electricity, and foundations.

4.3. Every three months ANC will draw up and forward to NF a construction progress report as well as final report.

4.4. On completion of the construction ANC will prepare and present a settlement of account.

GENERAL

5. On completion of the construction work this agreement will be terminated by an exchange of letters between the parties.




8. The validity of this agreement is subject to the approval of NF's International Committee, which must be given by 28th May 1984.
