THE INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL FOR ADULT EDUCATION ANNOUNCES NEW EXECUTIVE FOR 1990 - 94

The new executive of the ICAE was elected during the Fourth World Assembly for Adult Education held at the Sukhothai Thammatirat Open University outside Bangkok, Thailand. The conference was attended by adult educators from over 100 countries who met to explore and celebrate the themes of "Literacy, Popular Education and Democracy".

The new President, Dr. Francisco Vio Grossi from Chile, replaces Dame Nita Barrow who held the position for two terms (eight years). Vio Grossi is widely recognized as a world leader within the popular education and non-governmental organization movements. ICAE's new president is the founding Secretary General of the Latin American Council for Adult Education (CEAAL), and also founding Director of "El Canelo de Nos", Chile's largest popular education centre.

Paulo Freire, the renowned Brazilian educator, continues to hold the title of Honourary President. Budd L. Hall will continue for another term as Secretary General working out of the Toronto Secretariat Office and Edmund Gleazer, Jr. from the United States was re-elected as ICAE's Treasurer.
