## SECRETARY'S REPORT AND CORRESPONDENCE

- 3.1 Sipho Masuku was assessed and was found to be academically very weak. He should join Adult Education.
- 3.2 Solly Rasebotsa, request to apply for studies independently. To be advised to follow procedure.
- 3.3 30 candidates are required for Post and Communication Course in Harare. NSC to identify candidates.
- 3.4 Candidates are needed for ACCESS course organised by Cannon Collins UK.
- 3.5 Sangweni in Kenya request funding for his child. To be advised to follow procedure.



- 3.6 ILO Turin offers the NSC various short courses. A circular to be sent.
- 3.7 NSC received unsigned letter from the ANC students in IDM Morogoro complaining about administration of AAI funds. This triggered review of students in Tanzania.
- the meeting noted that lack of transport for NSC to monitor students in the region is a serious setback.
  - there are unnecessary delays in the remittance of funds for student fees.
  - some students are doing well.
  - the NSC to continue placing students in Tanzania but should improve the style of work.
