I have now had a chance to speak to my colleagues in Geneva concerning the proposals you put to me on the 23rd September.

I am pleased to be able to tell you that we accept the proposals you have made with enthusiasm. You may feel assured in your dealings with the Open University Association of University Teachers that we would be willing to support such a venture both financially and in relation to identifying appropriate candidates for your courses.

We feel that the extension of Open University tuition to South African victims of apartheid both inside and outside South Africa would be a significant contribution to the eventual liberation of Southern Africa. That your colleagues in the Association of University Teachers will share this view.
