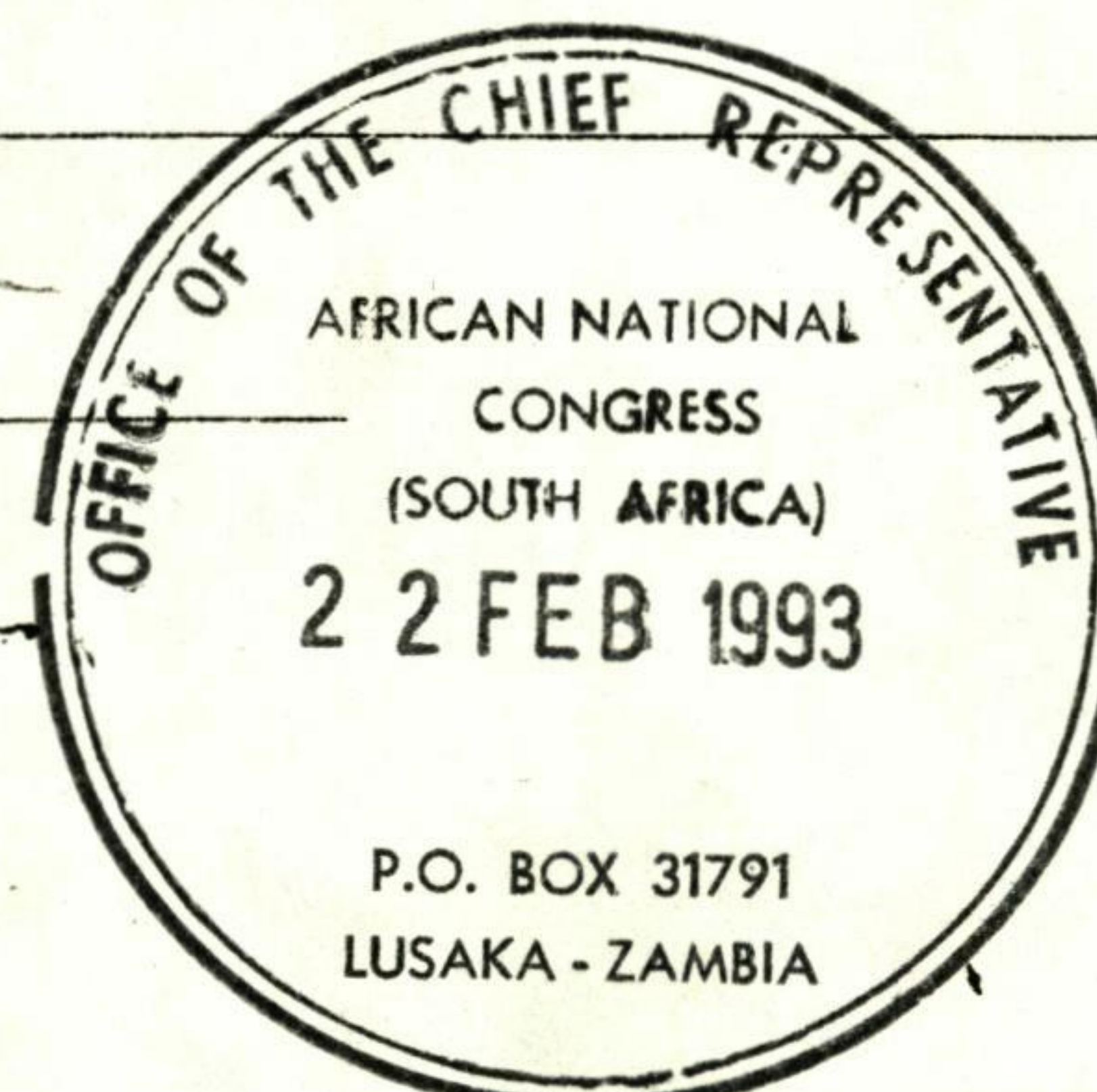

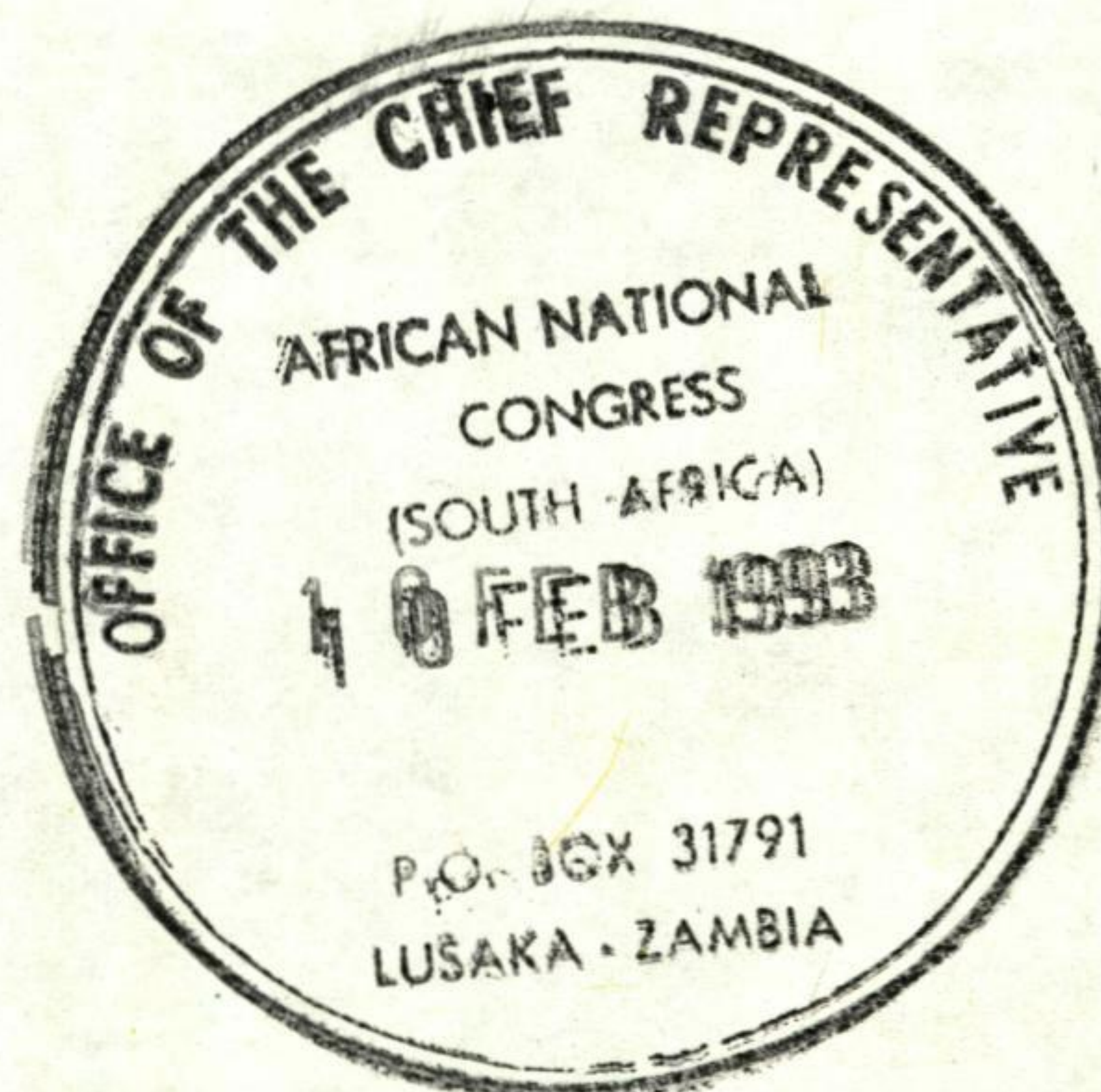

Introduction letter from DIA signed by Comrade Thabo Mbeki subject to the committee's strategy on international approach.

2. Proposed Local Fund-Raising Programme.

This programme must be seen in the light that the fight against apartheid has been a long and difficult one.

The campaign is still the a continuation of a fight against the destabilisation that South African racist minority regime led by the Nationalist Party, inflicted on the people and governments of the Southern African Region as a whole.

The fight was and is still the continuation of the vow taken by the founding fathers of the OAU and the rest of the African Population that of liberating the whole of Africa.

The fact that South Africa is the last in this liberation programme and has caused so much pain to the region should be the motivating factor for all people to contribute to the final defeat of this heinous system of apartheid.

Therefore, the ANC should not be seen to MONOPOLISE the funding of the election's campaign which is meant to deliver a final blow to this obnoxious system. It should be made to involve all people who have been victims of its aggression.

There must be too much noise in all corners of the globe in order to deliver a crushing and humiliating defeat of the apartheid system and those who have enforced it.

It should be treated as a Great Victory of not South Africans alone but of the whole world community.

3. Sympathetic to struggle against apartheid and concerned on current developments more especially wishing that violence

must come to an end.

A post-apartheid South Africa is expected to play a leading role in stimulating the economic growth of the sub-Saharan Region and the rest of the continent.

4. FODEP - This is an independent election monitoring group which can be approached for the following:-
 - training of monitors, documents and reports on elections in Zambia.
 - UNIP - ideas on strategy
 - MMD - " " "
5. Faxing, express mailing or DHL or the other alternative will be to arrange a mailbag system through Zambia Airways which is still to be negotiated.

This is necessary due to the fact that all letters that we received from your office seem to take some time to reach us.

6. -Video tapes on the following:-
 - ANC History, struggles, rallies, South African films, Musical, dramas etc.
 - Posters on mobilising assistance.
 - Documents on ANC Strategy and Policies must be sent regularly - on current events and elections campaigns inside the country.
 - Journals, leaflets, statements,
7. A co-ordinating structure comprising of at the most two people

with whom we can have direct contact and be ready to furnish us with whatever necessary materials.

8. The following should be taken into consideration:-
 - Use of South African musicians for performing in fundraising concerts in all african counties as they are very popular with the locals. (e.g. Brenda Fasie, Rebecca Malope, Lucky Dube, etc.
 - Concerts such as the 70th Anniversary Concert for Mandela in London should be arranged with the AAM's in those countries.
 - That some musicians like the Zairian Shala Mwana should be approached for performing in South Africa with the aim of raising funds for the ANC.

There must be a letter from HQ signed by President Mandela or by any member of the National Working Committee. This letter will then be dispatched with a covering letter of the ANC Zambia Mission. The letter must be different for each individual and organisations.

In the covering letter of the Zambia Mission it will be specified what form of support is requested from each individual and organisation.

9. We would also like to be clarified on the funding of the kick-off of this programme if HQ approves it.

In addition we request you to furnish us with details of addresses and Account No. to be used incase of direct donations being made.

The Local Fund-raising Programme has been divided as follows:-

Proposed Stages.

Stage 1: (Planning)

- Meeting and analyzing document from HQ
- Identifying potential donors
- Formation of Committee to handle the local fund-raising
- Compiling of list, addresses
- Dividing work amongst Committee
- Giving Feedback to HQ (proposals)

NB. commencement of the next stages depends on response from HQ.

Stage 2: (Kick-off)

- Posting of letters of request to donors and printing of adverts on newspapers, radios, and TV.
- TV interviews to announce the kick off
- Showing of tapes on TV (apartheid crimes, history of ANC, suffering of our people, state of economy, etc.)
- Showing of Rallies addressed by ANC leadership at home-TV.
- Analysis of response and feedback to HQ

Stage 3: (The Anvil)

- Music Concert by some South African Musicians
- Soccer matches by some S.A. clubs (chiefs, Pirates with players like Dr Khumalo and David Nyathi)
- TV tapes on election's campaign and ANC/developments/history/rallies
- Fundrasing dinners (presence of some leaders from HQ)
- South African films (mapantsula, asinamali, Bopha etc.)
- Select side of South Africa to play the Zambia National Team
- More TV appearances and debates ANC officials from HQ or members of the local committee.
- Analysis of the progress made and feedback to

HQ

Stage 4: (The Hammer)

- Concerts by South African musicians
- More matches by South African clubs
- TV appearances and tapes on South African situation and ANC rallies.
- A concert by South African Musicians combined with a soccer match between clubs or select side versus the local national team
- Visit by ANC senior official(s) - President or the Vice-President
- TV interview by the above officials, counting of the total amount raised and announce it publicly and thank the people of Zambia for all their support that has been rendered to the Struggling people of South Africa.

NB: Stage five happens after the results have been announced.

Stage 5: (Peace and Friendship)

- Staging of concert by South African musicians
- Soccer match either between clubs from home and local ones or between a select side and the local national team.
- Proceeds from the two events be donated to the people of Zambia.
