 We are a South African Scholapship Organisation  
 established in 1982 by the African National Congress of  
 South Africa. We are registered as an independent  
 organisation under English law. Our Memorandum and  
 Articles of Association are attached to this letter -  
 as is the latest list of our Trustees.  
 As you will see from our Memo and Articles, we were  
 established mainly to provide scholarships For black  
 South Africans (inside and outside South Africa) to  
 ensure that a post-Apartheid South Africa has a  
 reasonable number of qualified black personnel in all  
 walks of life - Agriculture, Industry, Transport and  
 Communications, Medicine, Law, Accountancy, Banking,  
 Administration, Management, Education etc. - to make  
 their participation in the governance of their Country  
 meaningful. The importance of this effort will be  
 obvious to you because your people have, through  
 relevant education and training, achieved economic,  
 industrial and technological miracles in less than a  
 century. Black South Africans are at the beginning of  
 that process; they need your help. We hope that it will  
 be forthcoming. To enable you to consider this reqUESt, I
