PROJET TITIE: TAILCRING AND SEWING PROJECT

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' GENERAL BAKGRGIND

With the inflow of students to the Morogoro School, there has been a great need for vocational training. Included in the training is the tailoring program. In the project, there exists factory buildings which have been made use of during the construction period to set up vocational training workshops. It is envisaged that the training of students in all of these skills can begin during the construction period as part of their participation in the project. Construction of the tailoring project will begin as soon as funds are available. . .

The tailoring and sewing project will be used to teach 20-40 students each year and also to clothe some of the students who have come with only the clothes on their backs. The aim is to achieve some level of income from the sale of surplus production in order that the ANC(SA) can achieve a high degree of self-reliance. At the moment the tailoring group is using an existing building which in the near future will need to be extended and renovated.

1. To erect, furnish and equip a tailoring workshop of 3'00 m².
2. To provide basic training in tailoring and sewing to approximately 40 students.
3. To supply clothing to the local community in the name of M(SA).

4. To generate income to help both the trainees and the ANC(SA) to become more self-reliant. .

OPEYATIWA PLAN

At the head of each working team will be an instructor who will be training the students. The building of the project will be undertaken by ANC(SA) personnel based in Morogoro. . .

The students will start by learning manual skills of sewing, stitching, buttonholing, etc., even before the machines are installed. After they have mastered the skills, they will move on to hand-driven, and later, electric-powered machines and equipment.

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All funds which are received for this project will be administered through: the Treasury Department, M(SA) Nakara, accounted for by the Morogoro Project Officer.

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
