OH 27th August 1971*

In terms of a decision of the national Executive Committee, an

enlarged meeting of the executive is being planned to take place on the 27th August at a venue in Zambia* The National Executive Committee is inviting leading members of the Youth, Women, former members of the NBC, Chief

Representatives of the external offices of our organisation and leading members of Umkhonto we Sizwe to participate at the meeting*

It can then be safely assumed that between 30 and 40 people or possibly a little more will participate at the meeting*

It is necessary that a machinery should be set up under the direction of the Lusaka A.N.C.* office to ensure the successful convening of the meeting*

Members of the BBC based in Lusaka will be expected to give the necessary assistance to the Lusaka office to ensure the effective functioning of the machinery*

We propose that the following should be attended by various sub-committees which should be organised as soon as possible*

(a) The Lusaka office should immediately make applications for the entry of those of our comrades who will be coming from overseas abroad*

It is assumed that firm arrangements for permission to hold this meeting have already been completed within the relevant department of the

Local Government Ministry* Otherwise the matter must be attended to without further delay*

(b) A reception and accommodation Committee should be set up to ensure that delegates arriving from outside Zambia are received and properly accommodated. We propose that the Special Committee which is functioning in Lusaka should be given the above tasks*

The Special Committee should therefore see to it that adequate shelter is arranged for the delegates at our "base" where the meeting is to be held*

This will involve procuring and pitching up tents at the site* If tents are not available, it will be necessary that temporary structures should be

constructed and with the assistance of the logistics Department the committee should ensure that a sufficient number of blankets etc, are made

available, including the necessary toilet requirements*

This is quite a big job which will obviously require a lot of manpower*
We propose that every available MK comrade should be organised to participate
in this task which has got to be commenced with during the current week*

(c) A catering Committee should be set up* We propose that the local Branch of the ANC women's section should be given the task to organise this committee. This committee will ensure the procuring and the preparation of food for the delegates! the procuring of sufficient cooking utensils, dishes or plates, and spoons (knives and forks are not essential)*

(d) A transport committee should be set up* This should ensure that transport is available, liable for conveying delegates to the venue to facilitate the mobility of the various committees that have been set up. Tau-Tau,

Balaboy, Ntala and one or two others should be involved on this committee

e) Leading Cadres of our organisation will have gathered for this meeting and this places a serious responsibility on our movement to ensure that adequate security for the protection of the delegation is organised. A special security unit under the command of the Acting President and

the Interior, Security and Intelligence Section of our movement should be set up. Part of the task of this security unit should be to report on the inevitable rumours which are bound to circulate in connection with our planned meeting.

f) We propose that a documents committee should be set to prepare a report to be delivered at the meeting. This committee should be composed of our Acting President who should be requested to have the draft report ready by the 21st August for presentation to the full committee meeting.
