
FROM: M. TIKLY, NATIONAL COORDINATOR, AND DONORS CONFERENCE

- 1. The ANC Donors Conference will be an event of major international importance for the African National Congress. It aims to mobilise assistance for our external Projects, the re-establishment of the ANC in SA and for development programmes and projects in general. The Conference will present to the world our development strategy and look at ways of coordinating donors assistance.
- 2. Decisions are required urgently on the following matters:-
 - (a) the precise role that key donors will be expected to play at the Donors Conference. (See attached Memo)
 - (b) the format and content of the Programme for the Conference, especially the categorisation and objectives of the Commissions (a draft Programme is attached)
 - (c) the setting up of the Treasury Task Force to provide guidance to the remaining decisions and tasks that will shape the Conference.
- 3. The Donors Conference is the responsibility primarily of the Treasury and in the coming weeks all Treasury personnel are

expected to give the Conference priority. Specific tasks will be identified for each relevant Treasury Department and Department Heads will be expected in Arusha by February 2nd 1991. At the Conference itself you will have to do lobbying and assist in the Commissions.

4. Each Treasury Department is expected to prepare Project Proposals for the Conference.

ANC DONORS CONFERENCE

PROPOSAL ON THE ROLE OF KEY DONORS

- 1. The proposal that a few of the ANC's traditional donors should be given a special role, was given approval in principle at a meeting of the Treasury Secretariat in December 1990. However, no precise guidance was given as to who should be invited to play this special role or what they should be requested to do.
- 2. In view of the massive assistance over many years from Sweden and Norway, it is necessary to select them as special guests. Tanzania, as the host country should naturally play an important part at the Conference. The other two countries worth considering for the sake of a wider international representation are Nigeria and India, both of which have also made important material and financial contributions.
- 3. Should the special invitees be designated "Patrons"? What will they be expected to do?
 - (a) to present a statement of Support/Solidarity at the Opening Session of the Conference
 - (b) to have a representative on the Steering Committee of the Conference
 - (c) to lobby other donors before and during the Conference
 - (d) to provide financial assistance for the Conference
