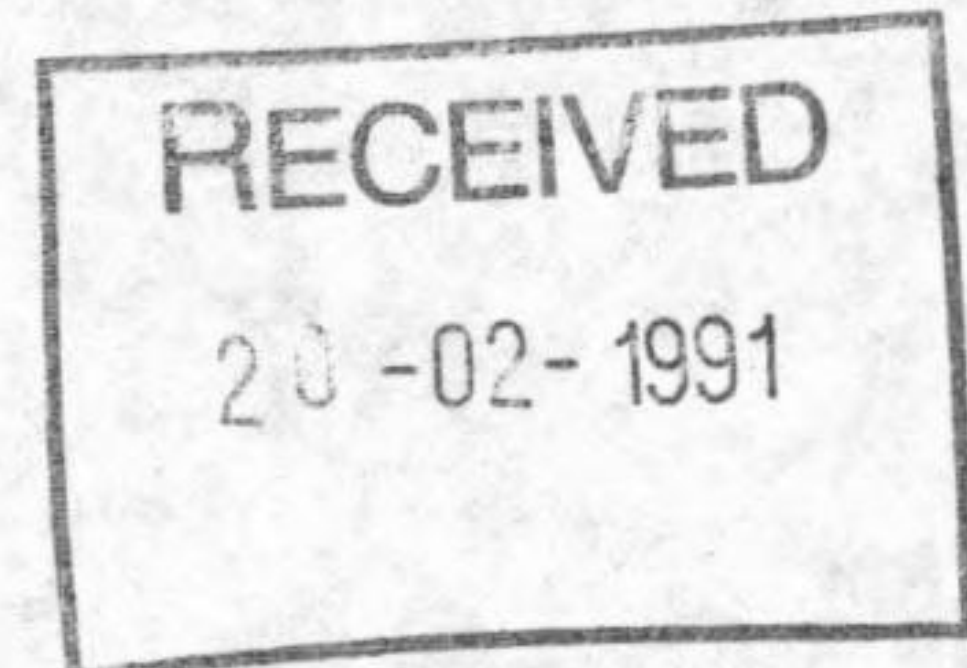

Dear Colleague,

Thank you for your letter dated 24 January, concerning cde Habiba Nahara. In this connection, we suggest that you clarify his status with the authorities in Tanzania as we were unaware that he had left for your area,

The only thing we know about him, is that on his arrival in Maputo from Mazimbu last year, he had told us that he had come to Mozambique for the purpose of being with his parents whilst awaiting his scholarship. We could not, however, corroborate this as he had not brought any official confirmation of this.

Thus even though he had not informed us officially of his departure nor where he was going, we were under the impression that his scholarship had materialised and was going to school. We also wish to further point out that we did not provide him with a ticket and were not in any-way involved with his travel arrangements to wherever he was going. Thus we have only become aware of his being in your area through his letter.

Kindly check with both Mazimbu and the Chief Representative's office in Dar-Es-Salaam.
