
Calling upon the N.Y.S. to convene an Urgent meeting of the N.Y.C. to discuss conference preparations.

4. The N.Y.S. shall form hence forth relate to you as an individual member of our Youth Section keen to make a contribution on the 2nd National Conference of our Youth Section and not as a cell or group of N.Y.C. members based in Zimbabwe.
5. With regards to your particular case, comrade Rikkie, I think you are aware just as the N.Y.S. is that you have really never taken your office as N.Y.C. member. It is thus also surprising to us that why are you now suddenly making this call - if indeed you are among the comrades who are making this demand.
