Dear Comrade Mohammed you will recall that ^{during} the Second ANC Consultative Conference held in Kabwe Zambia in 1985, the question of the strengthening of the Department of International Affairs was given prominence in order to enable our movement to meet adequately the growing challenges in the international arena.

Persuant to this decision, the leadership of the ANC has, for sometime, been exploring new and various avenues in popularising our struggle internationally. This entails the consolidation of ANC presence where ANC offices exist and the establishment of new ANC offices where the need and circumstances demand.

Accordingly the ANC has decided to open an office in Helsinki. It is envisaged that this office will help to intensify the campaign for the total isolation of the apartheid regime and assist in mobilising all-round support for our struggle. The office will also serve as a liaison between the ANC on the one hand and the Government and the mass organisations of Finland, on the other.

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that the National Working Committee has, with your immediate effect, designated you as Chief Representative of the ANC in Finland. You are therefore expected to wind up your present activities in Sweden as soon as possible and proceed to Lusaka for purposes of getting a full briefing.

May I take this opportunity, on behalf of the National Executive Committee and on my own behalf, to congratulate you on your appointment. We remain confident that you shall carry out this new assignment with some dedication as you have exhibited in your past assignments.

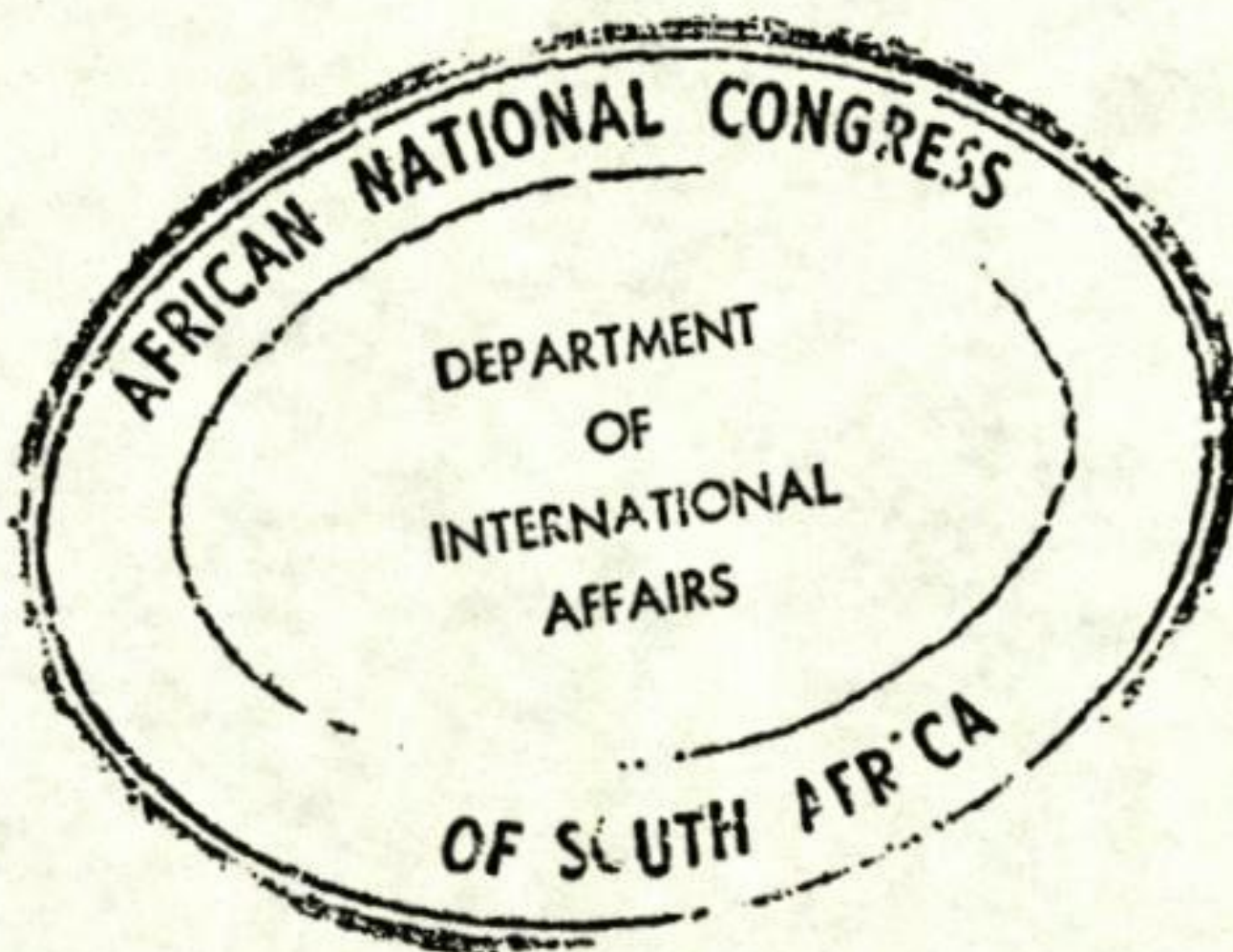
