FEVERISH preparations are under way to ensure that the African National Congress (ANC) anniversary celebrations. go off without heightening existing tensions within the tripartite alliance.

President Jacob Zuma kicks off the ruling partyâ\200\231s political calendar when he delivers the partyâ\200\231s traditional birthday message, which will be held at a rally in Kimberley on Saturday. This will be the ANCâ\200\231s 98th birthday celebration.

 $\hat{a}\200\230$ While he is likely to stick to the ANCâ\200\231s five-year script, which focuses on crime, jobs, education, rural development and health, all eyes will be on Zumaâ\200\231s ability to present and lead a united alliance.

Saturdayâ\200\231s gathering will be the first time senior alliance leaders share a public platform since the vicious war of words between ANC Youth League president Julius Malema and leaders of the South African Communist Party (SACP). Last year Malema stormed out of the SACPâ\200\231s special congress in Limpopo after he was booed by some delegates.

Malema and SACP deputy secretary-general Jeremy Cronin had traded insults in missives on nationalising mines in SA.

Some ANC insiders fear that Malemaâ\200\231s war talk last year might result in Saturdayâ\200\231s rally turning into an ambush for alliance leaders who
