# Row as former premier's daughter appointed IFP MP

THE appointment of the daughter of former KwaZulu-Natal premier, Frank Mdlalose, as an IFP MP in Cape Town, has stirred a hornet's nest among the party faithfuls in the northern part of the province.

Makhosazana Mdlalose, the eldest daughter of the former South Africa's ambassador to Egypt, was sworn in at the national parliament by Speaker Frene Ginwala last week.

However, her appointment has left a sour political aftertaste for her colleagues in the Amajuba district constituencies (greater Newcastle).

Amajuba district of the IFP has dubbed her appointment as an "insult" to local structures of the party.

"Our anger will be demonstrated in all sorts of demonstrations sooner than later. Recently we have experienced some defections because people were chosen by the top leadership instead of being recommended by local structures as agreed in our latest resolutions.

"Is the party going to add another Prof (Gabriel) Ndabandaba in parlia-

ment at our expense?" they asked.

Ndabandaba, the former KZN education minister, is one of the three IFP MPs who defected to the ANC.

The Amajuba branches charged that Mdlalose was not recommended by them and as such she would not be recognised by them.

The IFP leadership could not be contacted for comment, but the Amajuba District IFP chairman, Fana Duma, said he had not been informed about Mdlalose's appointment by the party's national council.

Milalose rejected objections to her appointment as "jealousy".

"Their allegations are unfounded. I am the chairman of the Newcastle ward two branch and I have been a member of the IFP since my youth. I do not think the leadership would have appointed me if they did not think I was suitable," she said.

Mdlalose, who served in the Newcastle local council from 1996 to 2000, has been an assistant principal at Nhlosokuhle School in Blaauwbosch, Newcastle. She will take up her seat in the national assembly when the parliament reconvenes on August 4 2004.

## Life on planet Ulundi

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The report by provincial auditor general Barry Wheeler was handed to the speaker's office early last year, but was kept confidential as it implicated various staff members, who were to face

disciplinary proceedings.

Among the more outlandish findings were that a Mercedes-Benz allocated to speaker Bonga Mdletshe collided with a cow when the driver deviated from the official route to buy vegetables, and that almost R1-million was spent on lounge suites and fridges for the legislative assembly flats in Ulundi. Much of the old furniture mysteriously vanished. There was also the case of the legislature website that never went online.

The African Christian Democratic Party's Jo-Ann Downs released the report to the Mail & Guardian this week, with the explanation that the house had waited more than a year for action to be taken based on the

findings of the report.

She said all but one of the 26 resolutions drawn up by the legislature's executive board in the wake of the report had been ignored. The investigation was instituted in response to several allegations, which included the following:

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· Serious deficiencies in the administration of legislative assembly flats in Ulundi;

 Misuse and under-utilisation of European Union funding of more than R2-million;

Purchase of furniture without prior approval; and

 Abuse of state-owned vehicles and cellphones.

Wheeler noted in his report that given the fact that the legislature is a 'relatively small entity" with an expenditure budget of R31-million a year and a staff of 114 and is run by a secretary and a deputy who earn salaries of R580 000 and R475 000 a year respectively, "one would expect the management and administration of the legislature to be well run".

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The findings also reveal that in 1998 the legislature paid almost R1-million for computer file servers, which have not been used. Some staff members spend more than a R1 000 a month on calls on cellular phones provided by the legislature. The report also points out that the legislature spent only 32% of funding provided by the EU.

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In one instance Mdletshe driver was instructed to bring documents to his house in Hlabisa from Ulundi for two consecutive days in 2001. Of the nine accidents that the report uncovered, seven involved staff from the speaker's office. Deputy speaker Willies Mchunu was the driver of one of the vehicles.

The report revealed that the internal arrangements committee of the legislature had purchased furniture worth almost R1-million in 1995, comprising 69 lounge suites, 69 fridges, 69 coffee tables and 69 bedroom suites for the legislative assembly flats without any motivation for the need for new furniture. The investigation was unable to locate any list giving details of the old furniture that was removed from the flats. However, 29 old fridges were found stored in a hall and 32 were reported to have been stolen while stored at the deputy speaker's official house.

Mchunu said the legislature could not comment as the report was still

confidential.
