Discussion between Dan church aid

DISCUSSION BETWEEN DAN CHURCH AID T.C.R.S. AND AND. 9TH. SEPTEMBER 1981.

- 1. In future all goods sent via TCRS will be packed in/containers which will be locked. We will purchase these containers.
- 2. Paints, linseed oil, etc. will also be included in these locked containers.
- 3. From warehouse to warehouse, goods should be delivered within 30 days.
- 4. Dan Church to send packing lists ahead so that port procedures can be started before the goods are cleared.
- 5. They agreed that in future, wood wool would be packed in crates with wooden corners to avoid damage.
- 6. The last order of cement is already on the water. Some of the smaller goods have not yet been despatched but will be sent very soon by airfreight this includes 2,000 light bulbs.
- 7. In future all orders from us via TCRS must be unified and numbered special order books to be printed for this purpose. Orders should be sent only on these forms with copies for TCRS and copies for ourselves. Items on order forms should be numerically listed so that when containers arrive they will have the order numbers on them, plus the numbers of listed items.
- 8. Smaller goods such as toys, etc. can also be included in containers.
- 9. We are required to submit a report to DANIDA as to the utilisation, so far, of their donated goods; Wexshould also send them an annual progress report. Agreed that we can send the one being printed by the Danish Youth Council, with the addition of an addendum what we have used, what is still required and thank them for specific items received to date.
- 10. DAN CHURCH recommended that we submit a special project document for to DANIDA for funding for Farm buildings construction. He agreed to take back drawings to sound them out on this
- 11. Future shipments will be via Soviet boats.
- 12. Items purchased abroad by DAN CHURCH will be reflected on invoices which will be sent to us with goods, and a statement of these will be sent every three months.
- 13. DAN CHURCH assured us that kitchen equipment for Unit 3 could be ordered through the Danida allocation, but he would have to check and will then advise us about cookers and fridges for staff housing, and automatic telephone system.
- 14. He promised to send us specific catalogues for tools and laboratory equipment, in English.
- 15. He would also investigate the purchase of napkin rinse units. which could be bought through DANIDA funds.
- 16. All correspondence would be conducted in English.

FUTURE DANIDA FUNDS.

DANCHURCH

- 1. We were informed that DANIDA is funding other projects over a five and ten year period.
 - We were advised to submit a project for the next five years, to be trnsferred to us annually a sum of 3,000,000 per annum. This should be a detailed project on construction costs. His office does all applications through DANIDA and he believed that the ANC had a very good chance of sucess.
- 2. Regarding an allocation of funds for the feeding of the students, he suggested we put in an additional project for this.
- 3. He also suggested that we make application to the E.E.C. who have a feeding scheme for the supply of wheat, meat, powdered milk, rice, beans, cooking oil, etc. However, this has to be submitted a year in advance.

T.C.R.S.

- 1. Over and above the DANIDA funds which they handle, they have a limited independent fund for refugees and exiles.

 Refugee Centre.
- 2. We could send in applications to be endorsed by the OAU/for items such as quilts, blankets, milk powders, soap/ Specific quantities of items should accompany application.
- 3. They also have a small fund of about 10-15,000 dollars. When we made our last request to them for goods, the Church Commission was in session and this generated much interest, and he feels this could spread throughout their organisation, worldwide. He believed that a plan, project description and report which could be dispersed through all the Lutheran Church groups in Europe, could well get aid for building construction, access roads, agricultural equipment, irrigation seed, fertiliser, etc.

Scholarships

It was reported that DANIDA is now administering the IUEF scholar-ships scheme. Talks between them and President Tambo had taken place and no doubt, information on this would be passed on to us from ANC Headquarters.
