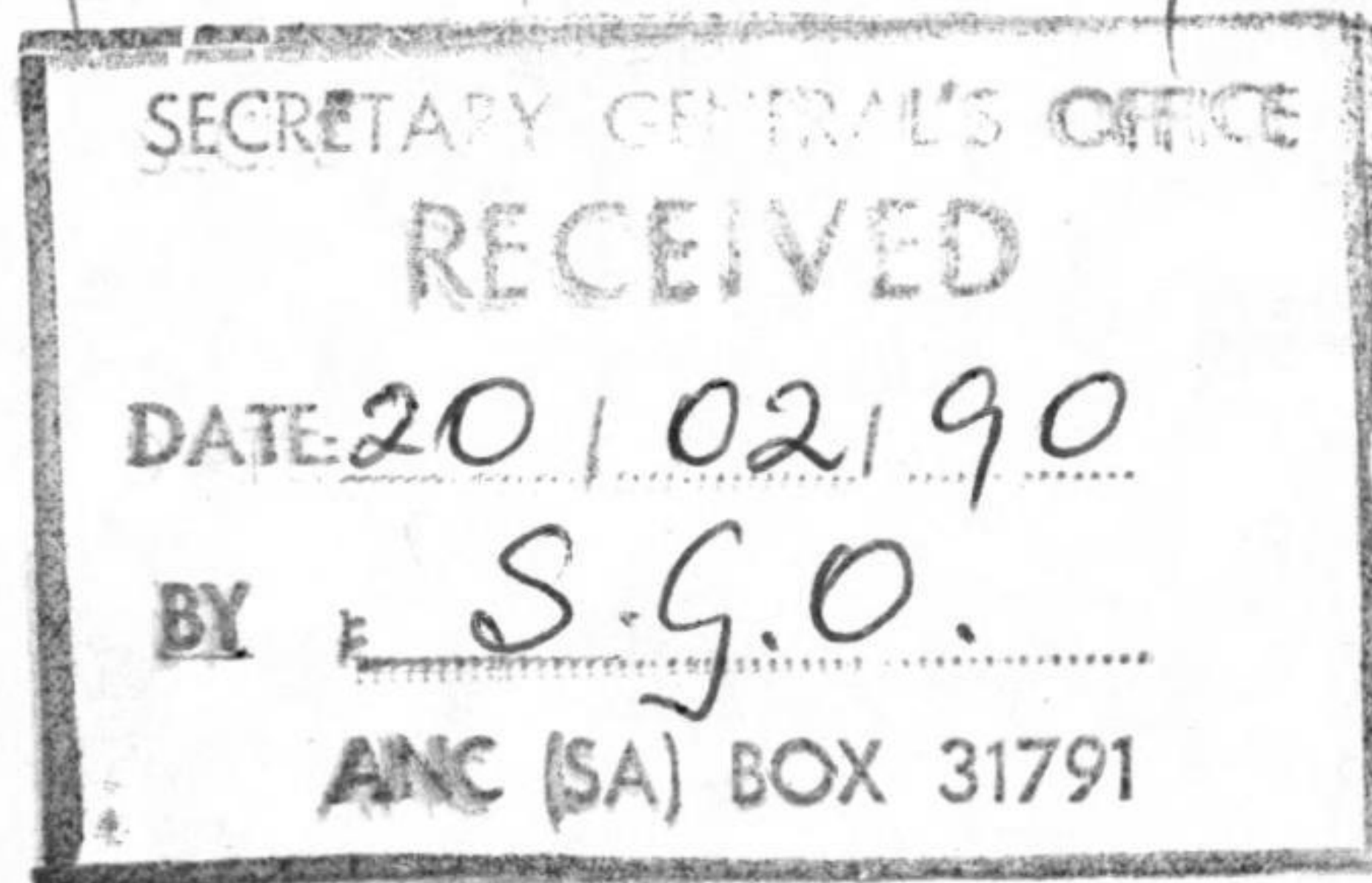

RE: REQUEST FOR ADVICE

Greetings in the year of Peoples Action for a Democratic South Africa.

Taking into consideration the unfolding situation in our country, I would like to ask for advice concerning the death of my husband, Comrade Victa Linga Khayiyana, who died in Pietritiff on 28th November 1985 and my son comrade Duncan Sipho Khayiyana (psuedo name Philip Manzini) who died in Yugoslavia on 6th January 1986.

I would like to be advised and informed on the death of my son who went for Military training in Yugoslavia. I have been told by the Womens Section that he got sick and died of an infection of the limbs. I was not in a position to neither bury him or see his grave.

I would also like to know, as awidow who lost her husband in the struggle, what would happen to the children.

I am not educated and I have three children who are fatherless. In this position that I am in (uneducated) what am I to do for my three children?

Please advise me.


