Dear Billy Modise,

I am enclosing a check for \$5,050 as a grant towards the humanitarian work of Matla Trust to help in your Community and Citizen Education Programme described in your funding proposal dated 1993/94. Like several of our previous contributors, this amount represents a product of the work of 54 outstanding popular artists who joined together in the Sun City project to sing out in support of the struggle for justice in South Africa.

The artists participating in the Sun City project specifically requested that a portion of their royalties be devoted by The Africa Fund to supporting the ANC's work with victims of apartheid. We believe that this criteria is excellently met by the work being done by the Matla Trust to provide education for democracy in preparation for democratic elections. I understand that these funds will help returning refugees learn about the democratic process that we all hope will soon be emerging in South Africa.

Many of the artists, including Steven Van Zandt, who conceived and coordinated the Sun City project, and Jackson Browne continue to be deeply concerned about issues of justice and liberation in southern Africa.

As you know, artists often feel most moved by direct personal contact with fellow human beings. I would be very happy to have any materials you have, however incomplete or anecdotal, which give a vivid sense of the work that is made possible by contributions such as the Sun City Grant. I am sure we could use such information to strengthen the solidarity already expressed, here in the U.S.

We would appreciate early word of the receipt of these funds, and in due course, a brief report on the expenditures of this grant.
