we still have a request pending for support for SOMAFCO. Meanwhile our documentation is out of date. I asked Dulcie some time ago to send us fresher material. She sent what she had (which was the same we had before)

Dulcie said she had requested more material from Lusaka and promised to send whatever would come. This was on the 10th of March this year. I am writing to you to ask you if something has come and if you could be kind enough to forward it to me.

I have another question concerning the funeral of Dulcie. We suggested to the Swiss Federal Government also to send a delegate. We did not hear from them. Did you hear of anybody from the Swiss Government attending or writing? We know that the Socialist Party took decisions and assume that you got their message but it would be important to know what the Government did.

A third point. The South African agents arrested in London had a list of people they should eliminate. As it has perspired that Switzerland is also on the hit-list of the South Africans we would of course be very much interested in names on these papers. You were in London at the time when somebody of the ANC was shown such a list. Could you communicate our wish to him/her?
