When I got to Maputo your husband was out and so the fruits were to rot. I gave them away. However, I am enclosing your Tanzanian forty shillings which is the money equivalent to the amount used for buying the fruit.

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In the meantime nurse the baby well. I hope you are assisting in the clinic. It is necessary for your practice.
