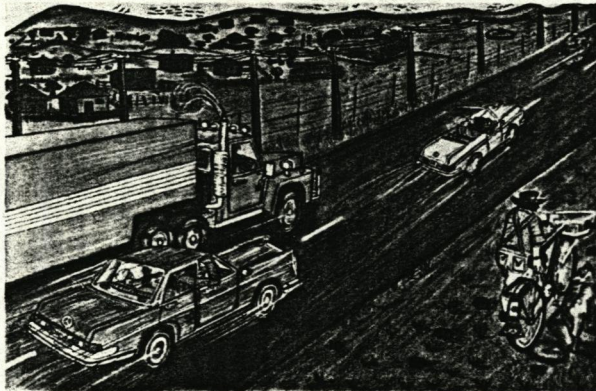




115. MOTSWAI, Thomas Tommy Trevor (b.1963)

Motswai, who was born deaf, attended Kutlwanong School for the Deaf in Rustenburg between 1968 and 1979. He has studied art intermittently at FUBA and the Johannesburg Art Foundation and has also taught art at Kutlwanong School for the Deaf. At the beginning of 1988 he began studying full-time as a non-degree student in the Fine Arts Department at the UNIBO.
